





# ALUMNI MEET 25'







The programmes featured hands-on workshops and training sessions on Python, Data Analytics, Web Development, Cloud Computing, Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning fundamentals, and Advanced Excel.

Students actively demonstrated their technical skills and innovative thinking by participating in national-level competitions such as the Smart Delhi Ideathon, Hackathon-AIDEVCON at SAP Labs, IISF Science & Technology Hackathon, and GGSIPU's 20th Annual Tech Meet. These platforms enabled students to apply theoretical knowledge to real-world challenges while developing problem-solving and collaborative skills.



Industrial visits to prominent technology platforms including India Mobile Congress, DIDAC India, and Art Asia 2025 provided valuable exposure to contemporary IT practices, advanced software applications, and emerging trends shaping the technology sector.

Complementing these initiatives, career development programmes such as seminars, mentorship interactions, and pre-placement workshops supported students in refining coding, analytics, and project management skills, guided by industry experts and alumni.

# BACHELOR OF LEGISLATIVE LAW



The Alumni Relations Cell of Maharaja Surajmal Institute organized initiatives to provide law students with practical exposure, courtroom experience, and advocacy skills. On 27th August 2024, students attended a session at the Mediation Centre, Dwarka District Court, where Sh. Manish Gupta introduced mediation principles and engaged students through discussions and role-play.

From 12th to 13th September 2024, fifty students visited Tihar Jail, observing inmate life, security measures, and vocational activities. Interactions with DLSA advocates clarified procedural aspects and offered insights into prison reforms.

On 14th September 2024, seventy students participated at the Lok Adalat, Dwarka District Court, observing live case resolutions, assisting with case management, and understanding swift dispute settlement mechanisms.



The Legal Aid Committee, with the South-West District Legal Services Authority, organized a visit to the Consumer Court, Dwarka Sector-20, on 25th October 2024. Students learned about hearings, judge-litigant roles, and procedures under the Consumer Protection Act.

SOMUN, MSI hosted a full-day Youth Parliament on 8th November 2024, where 74 students engaged in parliamentary simulations and debates on constitutional matters. Awards for Best Delegate, High Commendation, and Special Mention encouraged leadership and critical thinking.

Mooting activities continued with an Orientation Session on 1st October 2024 and the 3rd Intra-Department Moot Court Competition on 12th-13th May 2025. Students also excelled nationally at the FIMT Moot, KCC Moot, and Bharatiya Vidyapeeth Moot, reflecting MSI's strong focus on practical legal training and advocacy excellence.





